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Starting your child's education journey

Finding the right nursery place

Location is always a factor but it's only one element in the jigsaw. Other important considerations are the atmosphere and ethos of the nursery, the experience of the Principal and staff and how many children are in each class. Links with preparatory schools should also be assessed if you're looking at

a nursery as a route to a particular school. It's also worth remembering that competition for half-day places is always high and that full-day attendance can be particularly helpful if English is not your child's first language.
